

**Dress Code**  
**Updated: 26<sup>th</sup> May 2006.**  
**Revised: 2009, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015.**

Surveys indicate that the significant majority of parents in the Boyup Brook school community support a School Dress Code, and we urge parent help in ensuring student compliance with it. The Dress Code has been formulated with the aims of equity and economy, and to promote school spirit. We believe it achieves this and still allows students to express individuality. It is expected that students will wear the Dress Code with pride.

**General**

- Hair:** Longer than shoulder length must be tied back and be worn clear of the face. There should be no unnatural colours or stylised cuts (including but not limited to Mohawks and undercuts)
- Body Decoration & Piercings:** Visible body piercings are to be limited to the ears only. Piercings can be a safety concern, therefore are limited to small sleepers or studs (maximum 10mm in diameter) in a neutral colour (black, grey, gold or silver)
- Jewellery:** No more than one piece around the neck, and wrists.
- Cosmetics:** Limited to clear nail polish and natural toned lipstick or lip balm.
- Footwear:** Closed in shoe or boots. Sandals with backstrap.

**Uniform Items (available for purchase from the school)**

**Girls**

- Hipster Bootleg Long Pants – black (Stubbies Style SP1310)
- Cuffed shorts (MS & P) – black (Tudor )
- Girls Flat Front Skort (P) – black (Tudor)
- Girls skirt-black, worn with black stockings

**Boys**

- Cargo shorts – black (Stubbies Style SE078T)
- Cargo long pants – black (Stubbies Style SP078G)

**Boys & Girls**

- School Polo – red ( permapleat)
- Windcheater – green (permapleat)
- Jacket (MS) - red/green (permapleat)
- Lined hooded Parker – green (LW Reid) – (not held in stock, only orders)
- Bucket Hat- Black (Primary students- compulsory. Middle school- optional)

**Sports Uniform – Primary & Middle School**

- Black Knit sports shorts – unisex (LW Reid)
- House polo shirt – (Green, gold or red) (Stubbies)
- Black microfibre track pants (Middle school only) (Permapleat)

### **Middle School- Formal Events**

Boys-Black Cargo long pants and school red polo shirt

Girls- Black bootleg long pants and school red polo shirt

Girsl- Black school skirt worn with black stockings

Boys and Girls on Student Council- School Blazer and White shirt with school logo.

Both items available for purchase from local supplier – see the office staff.

The uniform is set as the above styles and colours. Please do not purchase any style of clothing not listed above. All items are held in stock, but orders are appreciated to ensure sufficient stock is available.

### **Physical Education (Middle School) and sport periods, carnivals, etc (all):**

Polo shirt in House colour (green, red or gold).

Middle school students may wear black shorts ONLY for physical education activities.

Primary students may wear black shorts the day of physical education activities.

For **Interschool Events** students are required to wear the school's red polo shirt with striped collar and school logo, and skirt / skorts / shorts (as for P.Ed. and Sport)

Strict compliance with the Dress Code will be a condition of participation on all occasions on which students are seen to be representing the school as individuals or as a group. This includes such things as Special Assemblies, incursions and excursions, and occasions such as ANZAC Day.

Long black trousers or the school black skirt and black stockings must be worn for performances by students in the Choir or Vocal Ensemble and for students participating in ceremonies such as Sandakan and Anzac Day.

Where there are difficulty obtaining items of the Dress Code – for whatever reason – parents are strongly urged to contact the school for confidential discussion on how the issue can be quickly and amicably resolved.
